



Restroom Policy

Children Under 5

- Workers will accompany a group of children to the hallway Renew Kids restroom.
- They must always go as a group, never taking a child to the restroom alone.
- The workers will first check the restroom to ensure it is empty, then they will allow the children inside.
- The workers will then wait outside the restroom door and escort the children back to the classroom once they are finished.
- If a child is taking longer than expected, the worker will open the restroom door and call the child's name. If a child requires assistance, the workers will prop open the restroom door and leave the stall door open while helping the child.

Children Over 5

- For children age 5 and above, it is required that at least one adult male accompany boys to the restroom and at least one adult female accompany girls.
- The workers will first check the restroom to ensure it is empty, then they will allow the children inside.
- The workers will then wait outside the restroom door and escort the children back to the classroom once they are finished.
- For the safety of all involved, workers must never be alone with a child in a restroom with the door closed, and they must never be in a closed restroom stall with a child.
- Parents are strongly encouraged to ensure that their children visit the restroom before each class.
